

The 36th annual GCU District 15 No-Tap Bowling Classic will be held on Saturday, March 23, 2019 at the Center Bowling Lanes starting at 3 PM. This popular bowling event has bowlers, male and female, bowl three games on different alleys. After rolling the first game on the alleys assigned to the entrant, the bowler then moves over to the next pair of alleys on the right until all three games are rolled. Another feature of this tournament is that there is an equal number of handicap and scratch prizes. This gives every entrant two chances to win a prize.

After bowling, all of the bowlers and their guests will proceed to our own Seven Oaks Country Club for dinner. Dinner will be served at 5:30 PM, with the awarding of prizes to follow.

This tournament is open to all members of the GCU. It is also open to GCU members who are not presently bowl-

ing in a sanctioned league. Such entrants may use the last average that they recorded in a bowling league. Current bowlers are asked to use last year's average, while new bowlers should use their average as of March 6, 2019.

Directions to Center Lanes, Aliquippa, PA

From Pittsburgh and East:

Follow Route 376 (old 60) North to Exit 42. Turn right, go through one traffic light. Go past O.C. Cluss to intersection staying to the right and make a right turn onto Brodhead Road. Go approximately 1 mile. Center Lanes will be on the left.

From Youngstown and West:

Follow Route 376 (old 60) South to Exit 42, turn left and follow the same directions as stated above.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Entrant must be a member of the GCU in good standing.
- 2. Entrants to use last year's (2017-18) highest average in any
- 3. Non-league bowlers to use last average posted in any league.
- Any entrant whose current USBC average, at the time of entry is ten pins or more above the 2018 average, must use the current average for this event.
- 5. If the entrant had no average last season, use highest average 12 games or more as of March 6, 2019.
- 6. Three (3) games will be rolled with four entrants being assigned to one alley.
- After entrant has rolled first game on pair of alleys assigned, entrant will move over to the next pair of alleys on the right and proceed to roll their second game, ditto the third.
- 8. There will be an equal number of handicap and scratch prizes.
- Tournament will use 75% of handicap—Men based on 200— Women based on 180.
- Maximum number of pin spot for men—40 pins women—50 pins—per game.
- 11. Entrant shall register at bowling alleys 1/2 hour before starting time.
- 12. All scores will be final after checked and signed by entrant.
