The Scholarship Committee of the Pennsylvania Fraternal Alliance is announcing that the 2019 applications are now available for the annual Scholarship Program. Applications can be obtained through eligible members of a Fraternal Benefit Society belonging to the Pennsylvania Fraternal Alliance or by contacting the Pennsylvania Fraternal Alliance Secretary-Treasurer at [Theresa@lpsc.org](mailto:Theresa@lpsc.org) or 888-834-6614.

Applicants must:

- Be a resident of Pennsylvania and a member of a Fraternal Benefit Society that is a member of the Pennsylvania Fraternal Alliance.
- Be a 2019 high school graduate attending an accredited college, university, trade school, etc. in the summer/fall of 2019 as a full time student (twelve semester credits).
- Obtain a recommendation letter from their Fraternal Benefit Society.
- Submit a 500-word essay on: **“What does fraternal mean to you? What would you do to increase the relevance of fraternalism to you and your peers?”**

Return the completed application, essay and letter of recommendation, postmarked no later than September 1, 2019.

At least one \$500 scholarship will be awarded. Additional scholarships may be awarded depending upon available funds.
