Antigua

(Information as of 4/27/2022)

Travelers from Mainland U.S. into Antigua testing requirements:

- 1) NOT required for fully vaccinated (14+ days after 2 Moderna/Pfizer shots or 1 J&J; booster not req)
- 2) required for unvaccinated/partially vaccinated -
PCR test taken 3 days prior to arrival OR Antigen test taken 1 day prior to arrival

Visitor Registration

A Health Declaration Form will be required to be completed upon arrival at Antigua Airport. This form is NOT available online.

Pre-Travel Testing

All UNVACCINATED travelers wishing to bypass quarantine, ages five and older, will be required to take a PCR test (no more than 3 days prior to arrival) or an Antigen test (no more than 1 day prior to arrival).

Testing is available at most CVS, Walgreens and Rite Aid pharmacies. However, it is important to confirm the turnaround time. There are hundreds of clinics across the US that offer testing designed for travelers who need results in a short amount of time.

IMPORTANT: Make sure to get a digital or paper test result as you will need this to enter Antigua.

Home test kits are not accepted as you receive no proof of test result from a healthcare professional.

Prior to boarding or when you deplane in Antigua, you should be asked to present your proof of negative test result. Keep this proof with you at all times during your stay in Antigua. Note that Antigua performs random screening and testing at the airport on both vaccinated and unvaccinated passengers.

Fully Vaccinated Travelers

Remember, fully vaccinated means you have had 2 shots with Moderna or Pfizer, or 1 shot with J&J. You do NOT need to be boosted to be considered fully vaccinated in Antigua.

Note that Antigua performs random screening and testing upon arrival at the airport on both vaccinated and unvaccinated passengers.

You should bring your CDC card as proof of vaccination, and keep it with you at all times during your stay.

Return to United States

A Covid test is required to fly back to the USA. GCU has arranged for these tests to take place at the resort, and cost will be covered by GCU. Upon check-in at the resort, you will receive details for your testing time and location.
