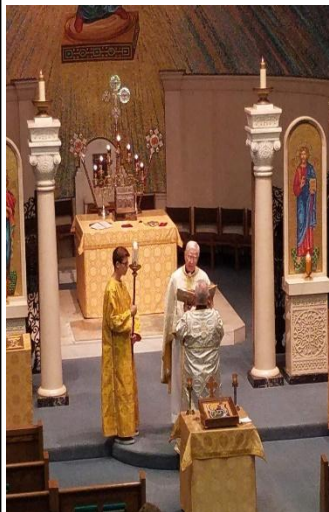
During Greeks Give Back Week, my brothers and I planted tulips and cleaned up the town of Slippery Rock.
